## Affiliates Programs

### EIPBN Affiliates Programs

EIPBN has a long tradition of corporate support. There are three major ways companies can participate in the conference:

- 1) Exhibiting in the **Commercial Session**
- 2) Becoming a **Corporate Sponsor** by providing additional financial support for EIPBN
- 3) Becoming a **Student Supporter** by providing financial support for student presenters.

### EIPBN Commercial Session for Exhibitors

Tuesday June 1, 2010: 3:00 pm - 6:00 pm

Wednesday June 2, 2010: 10:30 am – 4:00 pm

The 2010 EIPBN Commercial Session will be in the Summit Hall on the lower level of the Egan Convention Center. The Exhibit space will be contiguous with the Poster Session, and all breakfasts, coffee breaks and lunch on Wednesday (during the Poster Session) will be served in the same area as the Exhibit/Poster space.

Booth locations will be assigned by EIPBN.

All exhibit booths will be set up in the morning on Tuesday, June 1, and disassembled on Friday, at the same time the poster boards are removed. It is expected that Exhibitors plan to staff their booths on Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday during the times listed above.

If Exhibitors wish to keep booths set up and staffed for additional times on Thursday, for example during coffee breaks, please contact EIPBN management to make arrangements.

Prices for exhibit booths are:

A single space 8 feet x 10 feet (3.05 meters by 6.1 meters) **\$1,500**

A double space 8 feet x 20 feet (3.05 m x 12.2 m) **\$2,000**

Exhibitors are entitled to:

- Two (2) tickets to the Tuesday Welcome Reception, and
- A \$250 discount on sponsorship activities (see the next section).

To reserve exhibit space, please fill out the Registration Form online or download the PDF 2010 Exhibit Registration Form and send in payment to reserve your space.

All exhibitors are encouraged to also consider sponsorships, either of specific events (breakfasts, coffee breaks, etc.) or more generally of the conference itself. Company sponsorship of students is especially encouraged.

## EIPBN Corporate Sponsorship

## EIPBN Student Support

Today's students are the future of our conference, and also potential employees of our sponsoring companies.
